Our Online Privacy Practices

Keeping financial and personal information secure is one of our most important responsibilities. Commonwealth Central Credit Union is committed to protecting the information of members and visitors who use our website. We value your trust and handle all personal information with care.

As with information we collect through other means, we use the information you provide online to respond to your needs, service your accounts, and provide you information about other services.

Secure Transmissions

To ensure information remains confidential, Commonwealth Central Credit Union uses Secure Socket Layer (SSL) encryption technology to protect information you enter and submit from our website.

Email Security

Email is not a secure method of contact. You should never provide information that is sensitive or confidential, such as your social security number, account number, or PIN, through unsecured email.

Cookies

A cookie is a small piece of information that a website stores directly on the computer you are using. Cookies can contain a variety of information, from a simple count of how often you visit a website to information which allows customization of a website for your use. Commonwealth Central Credit Union uses cookies to gather data about the usage of our website and to ensure that you have access to your account information. Anytime a cookie is used, personal information is encrypted for our use only and is protected from third party access (a cookie cannot be read by a website other than the one that sets the cookie).

Data Collection

Commonwealth Central Credit Union does not collect personally identifiable information about an individual consumer's online activities nor do we allow other parties to collect such information.

Third Party Links

Commonwealth Central Credit Union provides links to business partner websites and to other resource websites as a courtesy. A business partner website will be identified with our logo; resource websites will not have our logo, and are not endorsed by Commonwealth. Please remember that when you leave our site, our Privacy Policy is no longer in effect. Once you visit another website, your web privacy and security is defined by that website's own policies. While we hope these organizations join us in respecting your privacy, we offer these links only as a convenience to our members.
